

Y (A.D. 618 - 907)

The horse is in the position known as "the horse of the Tang Dynasty". The front right leg is lifted, neck slightly arched, and the horse is covered with a mat under the tail. The horse is in a good state of preservation, some areas of wear are visible. **ORIGIN:** This horse is composed of parts of the Tang period, including the head, neck, and body. The emperors of the Tang Dynasty were known for their love of horses and by importing beautiful horses. Most of the beautiful horses among them were trained to be used in the hunt. They possessed over 400 studs that were trained for the hunt. **MEASUREMENTS:** Height: 30 cm. **THERMO-LUMINESCENCE TESTS:** confirms the dating of this piece. Tests were performed on the horse's body and the results are as follows:
