### **GOLDEN EARRINGS WITH ROMAN FIBULAE IN BRONZE ROMAN ERA (1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> century)**

Pair of earrings with two bronze cast fibulae in a mould typical of the Roman era, mounted on 18 carat gold. Originally, the fibulae, (from the Latin *Fibula* meaning fasteners) are the ancestors of modern day pins. They were used to fix clothes draped on the shoulder or to hold the panels of a cloak, functioning as pins.

Fibulae could also have played the role of amulets to ward off evil, being as some were placed in sanctuaries as offerings.

Weight of 18 carat gold: 22.50 grams

Unique model executed by hand using authentic and ancient pieces of archaeology.

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
