Bijarcheo is the exclusive trademark of jewellery from Galerie Golconda, which crafts all its pieces in traditional manner. Each antique object, mounted in Italy by Alvaro and Correnti, is authentic and only noble materials such as gold and silver and natural stones are used. Beryl Cavallini owner of Galerie Golconda, is also gemologist.

NECKLACE COMPOSED OF NEOLITHIC FLINT ARROWHEADS MAURITANIA (2000 years BC)

This piece is composed of arrowheads dating from the Neolithic period. They originate from Mauritania. The flint arrowheads, locally called *boucharaye*, which in Hassanyya means "canine" are pointed and micro-serrated with bifacial retouching. The Saharan Neolithic period dates between 4000 and 2000 BC.

The arrowheads are mounted on gold and fixed on 4 threads of black leather.
Weight of 18 carat gold: 45.50 grams
