EARRINGS WITH PENDANTS

ARROWS FROM THE MAURITANIAN NEOLITHIC PERIOD (4000-2000 BC)

This set is composed of arrows dating from the Neolithic period of Mauritania. The flint arrowheads, locally called *boucharaye* meaning "canine" in Hassanyya, are pointed and micro-serrated with bifacial retouching.

Origin: The Saharan Neolithic period spreads between 4000 and 2000 BC

Pair of earrings with two flints of a dark ochre colour. These pieces are from Mauritania. The arrows are gold mounted and independent of the clip.
Weight of 22 carat gold: 12.30 + 14.65 = 26.95 grams

Unique model made by hand with ancient and authentic pieces of archaeology.

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
