## CERTIFICATE

**VASE IN TERRACOTTA**  
**CARTHAGE (ROMAN ERA – AD 3<sup>rd</sup> century)**

**MATERIAL AND TECHNIQUE:** vase in ivory coloured terracotta covered with a beige slip. Amphora style with a cared stone body typical of the Phoenician coast.  
Very beautiful state of preservation, without visible restorations.

**DIMENSIONS:** Height: 23 cm (9”) - Diameter: 21 cm (8.2”)

**TEST OF THERMOLUMINESCENCE** performed by QED Laboratory, which confirms the dating of this piece. Test n° QED1415/FG-0205.

**MUSEOGRAPHY:** a similarly shaped vase is exhibited at the Metropolitan Museum under n° 16.67.5, Rogers Fund as coming from Syria and dating from the Islamic period.
