## **CORNELIAN HEDGEHOG RING ANCIENT MESOPOTAMIA**

18-karat gold ring with sculpted, glossy hedgehog in cornelian from ancient Mesopotamia.

**ORIGIN:** it was from the second half of the third millennium that the production of cornelian objects developed considerably. These objects came mainly from artisan workshops located in the Indus Valley such as Mohenjo Daro, Harappa or Larsa. A workshop of cornelian beads was discovered in Larsa (Iraq), which revealed techniques of size and of perforation by picketing, percussion and using flint piercers.

Weight of 18-karat gold: 18.5 g
