### **OCARINA**

#### **ECUADOR – GANGALA CULTURE (400 AD)**

**MATERIAL AND TECHNIQUE:** vessel in a pinkish and shiny terra cotta showing some remains of an ochre paint on the face and on one leg.

**ORIGIN:** Ocarinas are small wind instruments in an ovoid shape (with globular tubes) drilled with 2 to 11 holes. Its origin is very ancient and many different types can be found, in many different shapes, all over the world. This one, which was found in South America, is of a particularly big size. The female is richly adorned with jewellery such as the Nariguera for the nose and bracelets.

**DIMENSIONS:** Height: 36 cm / 14.17 in – width: 15 cm/ 5.9 in

**TEST:** thermoluminescent test n° 21270306 by laboratory Kotalla confirms the dating.
