EARRINGS WITH NEOLITHIC FLINT ARROWHEADS

MAURITANIA _ NEOLITHIC - 2000 BC

This set of earrings holds two arrowheads dating from the Neolithic period of Mauritania. The flint arrowheads, locally called *boucharaye*, which in hassanyya means "canine" are pointed and micro-serrated with bifacial retouching. The Saharan Neolithic period dates from between 4000 and 2000 BC.

Weight of 22 carat gold: 21 grams
Small handmade chain in oxidised silver.
