RARE PARURE OF DIAMONDS, CORAL AND GOLD ITALY (19th century)

Set of four 14 carat gold pieces, consisting of rams' heads and diamonds set in silver. They hold an array of pendants, including a series of jars in chiselled yellow gold and heads of women in sculpted coral.

The set consists of a necklace, earrings, a ring and a brooch.
