BELT DAGGER IN BRONZE ROMAN ERA (1st - 4th century)

MATERIAL AND METHOD: Small belt dagger in bronze, highly oxidized with green patina from excavation.

A ring is attached to the dagger, it has a symmetrical blade and a very nice pommel with a frieze depicting a yellow serpent. There are no missing parts despite minor imperfections on the blade in some places.

The piece shows an ancient restoration.

ORIGIN: Roman era, between the 1st and 4th century A.D.

MEASUREMENTS: Height : 16,2 cm (6.3") mounted on a custom made stand not included in the measurements.
